This is a very important date in the church diary, not least because it is when the new PCC is elected, when we review the past year and look forward to the next and what God is calling us to do as a Fellowship.

We would also ask that you consider prayerfully who God is calling to serve on the new PCC after the AGM, or indeed whether He is calling you. It is always good to have some new faces, and maybe you are being called to be one! Nomination forms for election of Churchwardens and PCC will be available mid March.

This year encouragement is being given to each area of the fellowship to ensure they are represented on Church Council. However, it is also important that there is wider representation and if you want to know more about the way PCC operates and what membership involves please speak to one of the CW or any member of the current PCC.

Under our revised way of working twelve members are elected to PCC.

#### **ELECTORAL ROLL**

The Electoral Roll is the closest thing we have to membership in the Anglican Church. Ahead of the 2025 PAGM the PCC is required to revise the Church Electoral Roll. This means that the existing roll will cease to be valid and in order to be included on the new roll it is necessary for everyone to complete a fresh application which you will find on the table at the rear of the church.

If you consider yourself a member of Holy Trinity we would love to have you on the Electoral Roll in order that you can participate fully in the decision making of the church, including voting at the PAGM and standing for membership of the PCC or any other office, Should you have any questions about coming onto the Electoral Roll please have a word with one of the Wardens (Chris or Ian) or Margaret. Forms need to be completed by the beginning of April.
