MISSION UPDATE

Holy Trinity allocates 10% of regular giving to mission and that is divided between 4 mission areas: Church Mission Society (CMS), Church Pastoral Aid Society (CPAS) our patrons, Lira Projects which Ian and Shelagh worked with in Uganda and the Mission Fund. Mission group meets to decide, amongst other things, what people or projects are supported by the Mission Fund. We sponsor a child through Compassion and just recently have agreed two one-off donations. We have given £1000 to a CMS local partner, Bisoke Balikenga and £500 to Bible Society. Bisoke runs a Peace Centre in Bunia in Eastern DRC, where there has been a great deal of fighting, often supported by Rwandan militia, and millions of people have been forced from their homes. The Peace centre runs trauma healing projects especially for young people but also for families and is currently almost overwhelmed by need. Ian and Shelagh have met Bisoke on a number of occasions and he is an amazing man of God. Please pray for him and his wife, Furaha, who has been in poor health for some time.

The Bible Society have been running a programme to provide Farsi language bibles to believers in Iran, where it is dangerous to be openly a Christian, despite this there is an increasing number of believers. This and similar programmes need support.
